What Does the Service Look Like?

When a presentation or training is requested, information regarding the specific need(s) of the group is first gathered to determine whether it is a topic that Footsteps of Change can offer. If no specific need has yet been identified, a list of topics Footsteps of Change has addressed in the past can be used as a guide. Once a topic has been selected and all other pertinent information has been discussed, the training is scheduled and materials are developed based on the selected topic, audience needs, and allotted time. Formats may vary between lecture, question—and—answer, or hands—on/workshop styles (or some combination of these) depending on preference, topic, and time frame.

What is the Cost?

Presentations are billed at a flat rate, based on the complexity of the topic and the length of the presentation/training. Costs typically range from \$400 to \$1,200, which not only includes the event, but also the preparation time and any materials needed.

What Topics are Available?

Although a wide range of topics are available, some examples include addressing problem behavior, writing behavior plans, understanding the basics of applied behavior analysis (ABA), promoting independence, preparing for students with autism spectrum disorder, teaching new skills., toilet training, treating food selectivity, evidence-based practice, and graphing & using data.

Who is the Intended Audience?

Although education professionals utilize this service most frequently, presentations can be tailored to any other professional or community group such as daycares, parent support groups, first responders, and recreation centers, among many others.
